

TOO MUCH CHRISTMAS!



Caution:

If you elect to use an iron on product to assemble head and affix to sweater, be aware that faux fur will melt.

Use paper, low to medium iron temperature, move iron constantly, and be careful!

Supplies:

Scraps of felt in light blue, medium blue, black and white

9" x 12" piece of faux fur

Dark colored Thrift Store sweater (dedicated to project)

Various small Christmas themed Thrift Store items:

Items in photo are representative of the type of items appropriate to the project. Additionally, small bows, ornaments and similar items will work.

Scraps of ribbon and tinsel.

Hot glue gun

Assembly:

Cut out and assemble eyes and mouth as shown below.

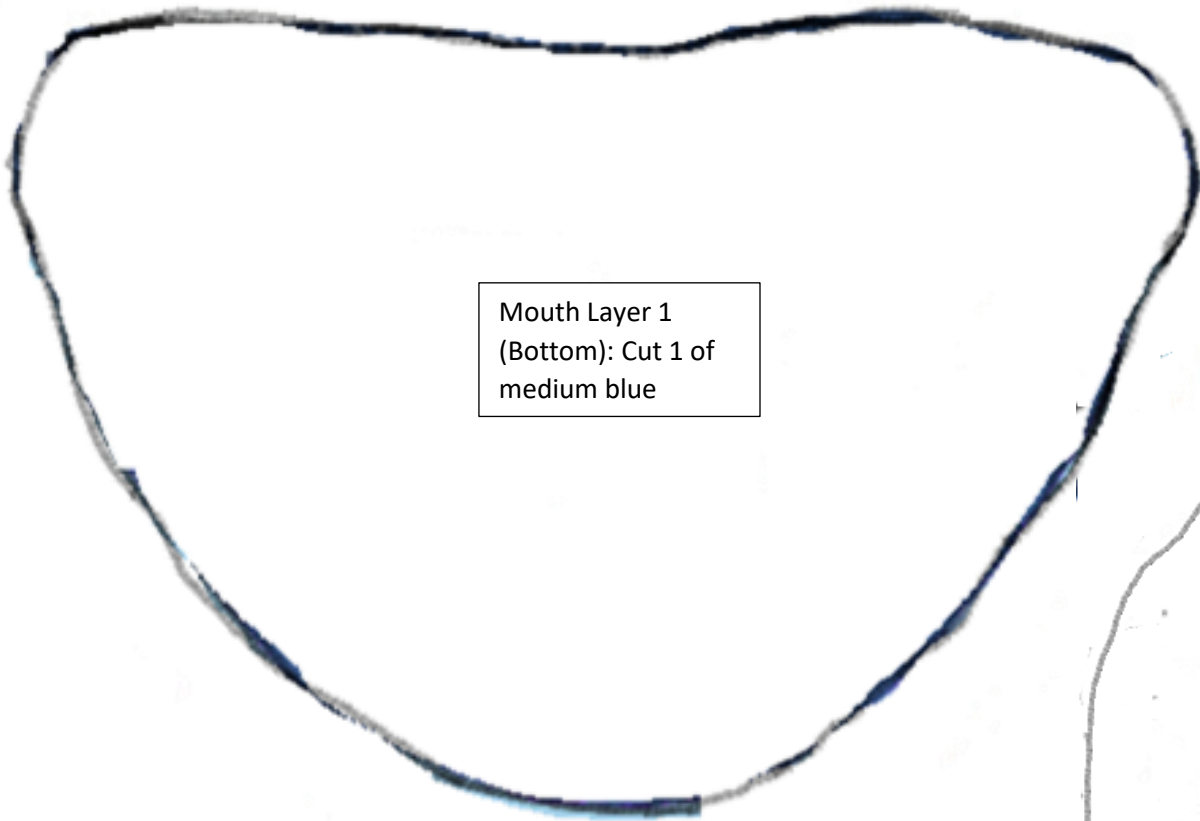
Round off corners of faux fur.

Finger-comb faux fur away from center in all directions.

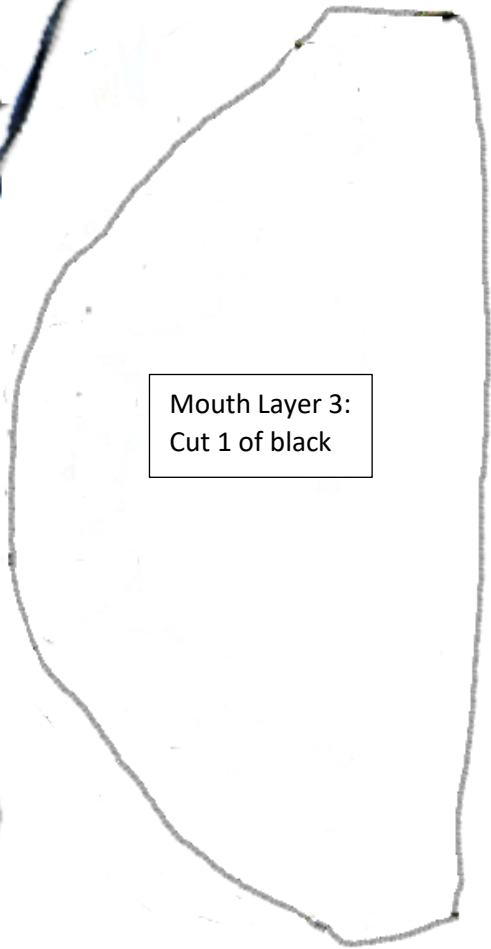
Apply eye and mouth assemblies to faux fur with hot glue gun.

Affix assembled head to sweater as desired.

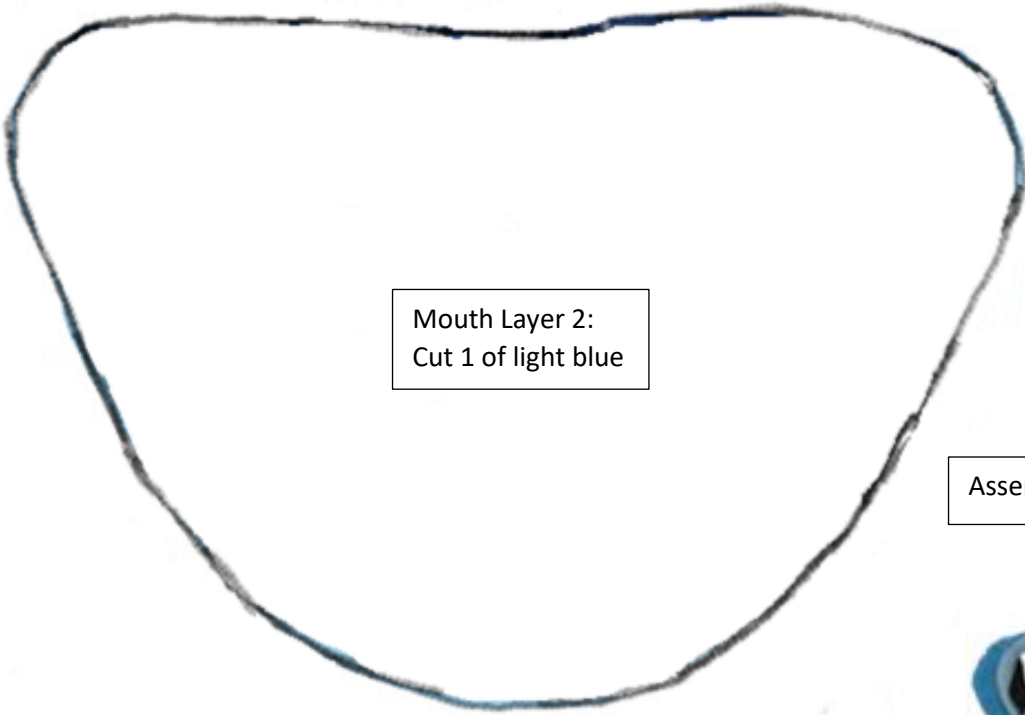
Arrange and apply embellishments with hot glue gun



Mouth Layer 1
(Bottom): Cut 1 of
medium blue



Mouth Layer 3:
Cut 1 of black



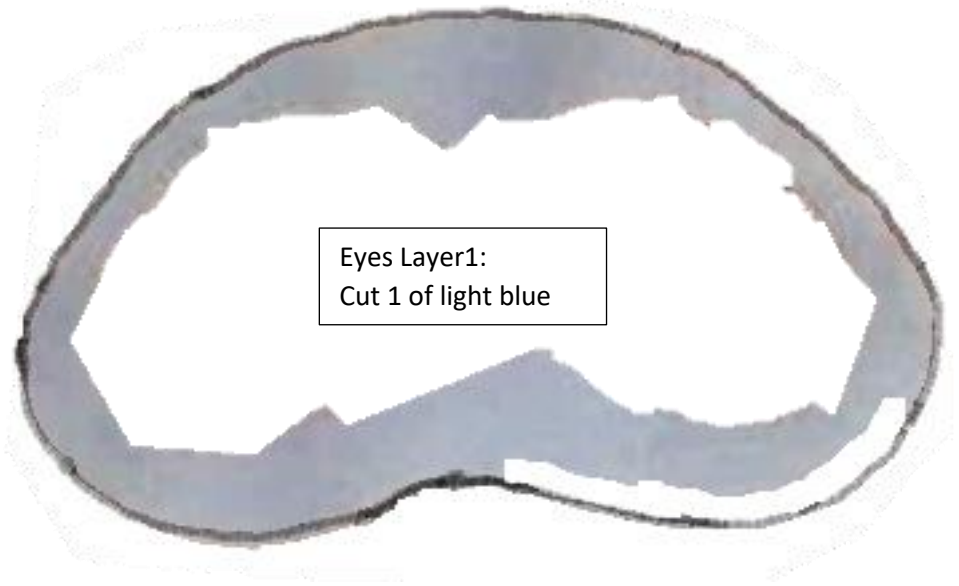
Mouth Layer 2:
Cut 1 of light blue

Assemble mouth as shown:



Print Scale:
Square to the left
should measure
exactly 1" X 1"

Assemble eyes as shown:



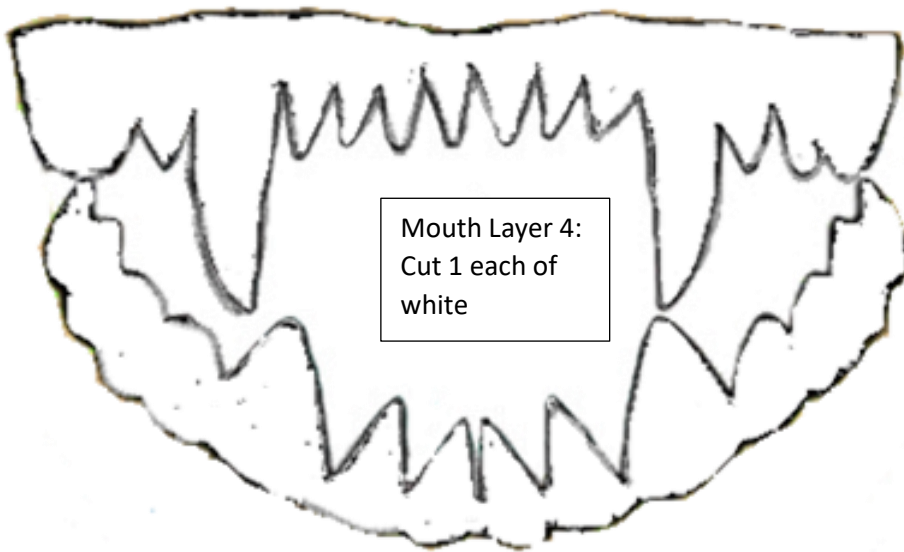
Eyes Layer1:
Cut 1 of light blue



Eyes Layer 2:
Cut 1 each of
white



Eyes Layer 3:
Cut 1 each of Black



Mouth Layer 4:
Cut 1 each of
white

Note: Top teeth and bottom
teeth are 2 separate pieces
Discard area in-between
